

Have you heard?



We can claim up to 45% on donations that total €250 or more in a tax year.

It's really easy!
Simply sign a form and watch your gift grow.



As you've donated to Irish Hospice Foundation (IHF), we can claim the tax relief on your donations if they total €250 or more in a calendar year. To allow us to claim the relief on your behalf, you need to complete an Enduring Certificate (CHY3 form) and return it to IHF.

It works like this:

What you gave in a calendar year	What it could be worth to IHF after claiming tax relief
€250	€362.50
€500	€725
€1,000	€1,450

Am I Eligible?

As long as you are a tax payer in Ireland, PAYE or Self Assessed, IHF can claim tax on your donations. If your donations to IHF in any one of the last four years add up to €250 or more, we are eligible to claim tax on your donations. Just fill out your Enduring Certificate (CHY3 form) and send it back to us with your PPS number and signature.

What is the Enduring Certificate?

Signing an Enduring Certificate (CHY3 form) will allow IHF to claim tax relief on any qualifying donations for a period of five years. This does not mean you are obliged to give for the next five years, but if you do choose to support us again, we can make a claim without having to contact you about this every year.

Our Commitment to You

Your information will be kept confidential and secure. We will only use your PPS number for the purpose of obtaining tax relief on your generous donation.

If you stop paying taxes please let us know so we don't apply for tax claim on any further kind donations you make.
